ADDITIONAL PRIVACY POLICY PROVISIONS APPLICABLE TO CALIFORNIA RESIDENTS

1.0 Categories of Personal Information Collected

In the last 12 months, we collected the following categories of Personal Information about visitors to our websites:

5.0 Your Rights Under California Law

- 5.1 Right to Know. Under California Law, you have the right to submit a verifiable request to know:
 - The categories and specific pieces of Personal Information we have collected about you;
 - The categories of sources from which we collected the Personal Information;
 - The categories of Personal Information we sold or disclosed to a third-party (other than a service provider) for a business purpose and the categories of recipients of that information; and
 - The business or commercial purposes for our collection, disclosure or sale of Personal Information.
- 5.2 **Right to Delete**. Under California Law, you have the right to submit a verifiable request **to delete** your Personal Information we have collected from you.
- 5.3 **Right to Correct**. Under California Law, you have the right to submit a verifiable request **to correct** inaccurate Personal Information collected from or about you.
- 5.4 **Right Against Discriminatory Treatment**. Under California Law, we cannot deny goods or services, charge you a different price or provide a different level or quality of goods or services just because you exercised your rights under the California Privacy Rights Act. However, if you refuse to provide your Personal Information to us or ask us to delete it, and that Personal Information is necessary for us to provide you with goods or services, we may not be able to complete the transaction.

Please note that, before we are able to process your request, we must verify your identity. We accomplish this by verifying your name, email address and residential address. Depending on the nature of your request, we may reach out for additional information to complete the process. You may appoint an authorized agent to submit a request on your behalf. Any agent must be prepared to provide appropriate documentation verifying their capacity as an authorized agent and appropriate proof of identity.
